The UHealth Medical Center at Miami Jackson Senior High School located at 1751 NW 36th Street, will be staffed by a UHealth physician, ARNP, and nursing staff and will provide the following services:

- Preventive care, health screenings, and physical exams
- Annual health evaluations
- Routine care for women, including Pap smears, pelvic, and breast exams
- Physical exams for sports, school, and summer camp
- Flu shots, allergy injections, and immunizations
- Treatment of complex and long-term medical conditions, including diabetes and high blood pressure
- Lab services
- Treatment of minor injuries such as lacerations and splinting sprains

- Primary Care Physician Visit: \$10 co-payment
- Specialist Physician Visit: \$50 co-payment
- Diagnostic Testing: \$100 co-payment
